In the event of mission loss, partial mission loss or return failure, the following contingency orders will come into effect:

 Ascertain timeline integrity. If integrity is uncompromised, then all efforts are to be directed into documentation and/or return to original timeframe plus one second or nearest future approximation.

TOP SECRET

- If the integrity of the timeline has been compromised, all possible action will be taken to restore the temporal integrity of the United States of America. If, after such restoration, return is not possible, see 3.
- 3. In the event of definite contingency failure, the commander, within the constraints of the uniform code of conduct, will have full discretion to take necessary measures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of his crew.
- 4. Displacement technology within the mission vehicle must not be allowed to fall into the hands of other parties. In order to safeguard the temporal integrity of the United States of America, the displacement technology should in such cases be disabled.
- 5. When these contingency orders come into effect, the commander will have full executive powers within the confines of executing these orders. For further reference regarding this order, se enclosed NSC Directive 5413, section 16.
